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## Zema Estate Coonawarra Shiraz 2013

French and American oak become the seasoning for ripe shiraz grapes from Coonawarra. The wine gets a 14 month infusion and rest in barrels. Zema Estate has a very loyal following, and they are rewarded with few price rises, it seems.

Rich and ripe, medium bodied, soft and dark fruited, spiked with spicy oak and malt-powder tannins. Generous red of suppleness and flesh. Scents of school pencil case, leather Chesterfield, malt, coffee grounds, oyster sauce. Palate is punchy in dark fruit, currants and dates, leathery tannins and coconut-meets-dark chocolate oak. A certain expression, mostly in balance, good for those seeking some shiraz impact.
