Zema Estate Coonawarra Cabernet Sauvignon 2010

Zema Estate's Coonawarra cabernet falls into the highly reliable category. Never a dud but perhaps never a great high either. 2010 is a good to very good vintage.

Straight up it tastes good but with air it builds structure and character. You're unlikely to walk away disappointed from a bottle of this. Strong eucalypt and blackcurrant, dusty herbs, modest (and well integrated) spicy oak and a gravelly, gently tannic finish. Medium-bodied, clean and varietal. As they say in the classics: for now or for later.
