Zema Estate Coonawarra Shiraz 2014

Estate-grown, one of only a few to hand-prune in Coonawarra, with meticulous canopy management, matured in American and French oak for 14 months. Good colour; this medium to full-bodied wine paints a picture of Coonawarra in rude good health, not a deceptive note anywhere in its body. Blackberry and blood plum are built on foundations of polished tannins and an echo of oak. Demands respect for its traditional estate winemaking.
