2016 was a year of substance at Zema Estate. The labels changed and the wines have heft. Controlled heft. This is an excellent cabernet with a drive of fruit flavour and flowing curls of tannin.

Blackcurrant, malt, dried leaf/herb notes and a (very) gentle resiny/creamy aspect. There's an excellent push to the finish; it takes things up a gear. This is the best Zema cabernet I've seen in quite a long time.
