Zema Estate Coonawarra Family Selection Shiraz 2016

There's ample depth to this Coonawarra shiraz. There's a toasty, creamy, molasses-like aspect to the depth of scorched black cherry and plum.

There are hints of development but they are mere hints; it just has a mellow feel. Iodine and toasty spice notes act as highlights. This smells, tastes and feels substantial, and has a satisfying push through the finish as well.

There's quite a lot of oak here but the fruit is high quality and everything feels well integrated.
