Zema Estate Coonawarra Cabernet Sauvignon 2019

Deep crimson in the glass with a purple edge. The nose offers an attractive Coonawarra mix of blackcurrant liqueur and blackberries, over a background of restrained oak.

In the mouth the wine is full-bodied and dry, textured with subtle tannic grip. Intense dark fruit notes continue, leading to a concentrated, warm, and lengthy finish. Try now with hearty main course dishes, or cellar for 10 years or so.
